Finny (whispers in Teddy's left ear): I'm afraid that I'm sick. I itch all the time and have to scratch.

Chicka (whispers in Teddy's right ear): I'm scared of big black crows. They're so big and I'm so little.

Since both birds talk at the same time, Teddy is confused.

Teddy: Scared of sick crows that itch so big.

Chicka (looks upset): I told you a secret so you would help me. But you make fun of me instead.

Finny (*looks sad*): I told you something private, Teddy, and you make fun of what I told you.

Teddy: I was not making fun of what either of you said. The problem is you were both whispering in my ears at the same time. So your messages were jumbled together.

Chicka: We did not take turns. I should have let Finny go first."

Finny: Yes, we didn't take turns. I should have let Chicka go first.

Teddy: Now take turns. Tell me what worries you.

Chicka: I'll tell my worry out loud now.

Finny: I won't whisper my worry this time.

Teddy: Good idea! We can share worries and find help together.

Chicka: I'm scared of big black crows. They're so big and I'm so little. What can I do?

Teddy: You are small, but smart. You can outsmart a big crow any time.

Finny: Stay out of their way. Stay far away. (*stops*) I'm afraid that I'm sick. I itch all the time and I need to scratch.

Teddy: You are <u>not</u> sick, just itchy because bird mites are on you. They are parasites that feed on your blood.

Chicka: Tell the mites - I'll share my blood. I'll share my blood because I'm good.

Teddy: It's healthy to share our worries, instead of keeping them inside. Others can help us understand them.

Finny: Thank you, Teddy. Thank you, Chicka! You help me understand my worry.

Chicka: Thank you, Teddy! Thank you, Finny! You help me understand my worry.

Teddy: We found answers to your secrets and worries together.
