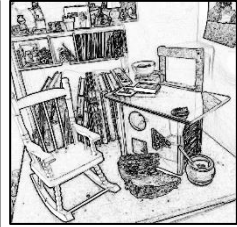




**FOUR

Characters: Teddy Bear Ay Fawn, Bee Fawn, Cee Fawn, Dee Fawn

Setting: Teddy's office

Teddy: Well, it's very nice to meet each one of you. Now tell me your problem.

Cee: Those two (*points to Ay and Bee*) are always fighting. And she (*points to Dee*) always yells at me.

Bee (*points at Ay*): Stop kicking me, you brat!

Ay (*shakes her head*): We do NOT fight!!

Dee (*shouts*): I do NOT always yell at you!!!

Teddy: I think I get the picture. Your only problem is that you are family. Are you nice to your friends?

Ay, Bee, Cee, Dee: Yes!

Teddy: Do you yell at them and fight with them?

Ay, Bee, Cee, Dee: NO!!

Teddy: Friends are different. You are nice to them. You think you don't have to be nice to your sisters. They are always there.

Cee: That's true, Mr. Teddy. I will try to be nice to my sisters.

Dee: I'm sorry. I'll try not to fight.

Ay: Me too.

Bee: I'll try to control my voice.

Teddy: That's good! I think you solved your own problem.
